Features

- 2 pages: one in English, one with the same text translated into Spanish
- Sidebar menu with links to both pages, available at all times
- Accordion menu for the FAQ section

Plan of Action

- 1. Create/modify pages
 - a. Can use existing pages and modify the content as needed
 - b. Reorganize page hierarchy and menu options so that Participation in Research page no longer shows up in the Research sidebar menu
 - By necessity, this will change the URLs of both pages. The domain name for the study (icancarestudy.com) will need to be remapped to the new page URL for the English version page.
- 2. Implement accordion functionality
 - a. This will most likely involve creating and installing a plugin. Plugin will include:
 - i. JQuery code for accordion functionality
 - ii. CSS to style the accordion to match the style of the site (as per mockup)
 - iii. Shortcode(s) for adding accordions in the WordPress WYSIWYG editor
 - iv. CSS to style the print version of the page (print version should ideally not have accordion; just plain text)
 - v. Any necessary features to allow pages with accordions to meet accessibility guidelines
- 3. Test
 - a. Can the pages be accessed from anywhere else on the site?
 - b. Does icancarestudy.com point to the new location of the English language page?
 - c. Does the code validate?
 - d. Are the pages accessible?
 - e. Are the print versions of the pages user friendly?
